Ms. Gaarlandt noted the recommendation was to move forward with Grau & Associates ranked as the highest ranked proposer with 100 points. District Management will respond to the proposers and request an engagement letter from Grau & Associates. The engagement letter will be sent to District Counsel for review.

On MOTION by Ms. Allen, seconded by Mr. Toledo, with all in favor, the Board approved the Recommendation of the Aud proposal of three years, and waived the three-proposal requirement.

Ms. Gaarlandt stated that these are standard District expenses that were already approved and are included solely for ratification.

On MOTION by Mr. Christie, seconded by Ms. Allen, with all in favor, the Board ratified Funding Request No. 325 - 336.
